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



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Summary

Key data for Bachelors' and Masters' thesis

Conditions

Students

- Writing a one pager about the chosen topic
- Combination of theory and practice as an essential element of the thesis

KPMG

- Selection of the topic in close coordination with KPMG
- At least one permanent contact person/supervisor from KPMG

Advantages

Students

- Promoting Collaboration between Academia and Industry
- Building Connections with KPMG and preparing for professional practice
- Encouraging independent work

KPMG

- Scientific exploration of interesting questions
- Contribution of innovative ideas from diverse study areas
- Meeting potential employees for KPMG

Duration

- Typically three to five months (depending on bachelor or master)
- Generally in the final semester

Compensation

- By agreement

Sample timetable for Bachelors' and Masters' theses

Application for a thesis


- Application with three suggested topics
- talk/discussion with Bernd Grottel

Coordination with the chair

- Coordination with the supervisor about the topic/familiarization
- Concretization of the procedure

Regular consultations

- Coordination of the concrete procedure/structure/definition of the thesis etc. with KPMG and with the supervisor at the chair



Writing of proposal

- rough elaboration of the topic in form of a one pager

Start of the thesis

Submission of the thesis

- Possibly defense at the chair
- Possibly presentation at KPMG

Content of the one pager/ proposal

1. Preliminary working title

2. Background/motivation/problem definition


3. Research question/objective

4. Methodology/approach

5. Rough structure of the outline (optional)

6. Timeline

Key data for project work

Conditions

Students

- Selection of the topic in close coordination with the practice partner
- No scientific work, but primarily practical benefits for practice partners

KPMG

- At least one permanent contact person/supervisor from KPMG
- Specification of the type of presentation of the results (e.g. presentation)

Advantages

Students

- Promoting Collaboration between Academia and Industry
- Building Connections with KPMG and preparing for professional practice
- Encouraging team work

KPMG

- Practice-oriented processing of interesting questions
- Incorporation of new findings from the project into company processes
- Getting to know potential employees for KPMG
- Ongoing assignment of students as part of the project work

Duration

- Three months full time


Team

- A project team consists of at least two to four students
- Students in advanced semesters
