Your Tasks:

- Step 1: Understanding the landscape Conduct an analysis of sustainability reporting standards applicable to think tanks, with a focus on the VSME standard.
- **Step 2: Stakeholder engagement** Identify key sustainability aspects relevant to think tanks by engaging with internal and external stakeholders.
- Step 3: Data collection & reporting Develop a methodology for data collection and draft the first Climate & Company impact report.
- Step 4: Creating a scalable framework Translate insights from the reporting process into a practical guide that other think tanks can use for their impact reporting.
